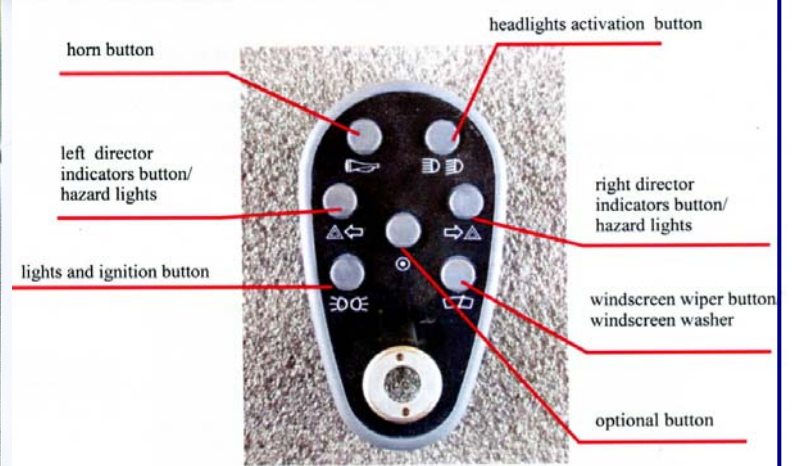

Steering Aid with Auxiliary Controls



The electronic power box is used by drivers with the lack of functionality to one upper limb. It works with radio waves and groups the auxiliary controls in a single box on the right or the left of the steering wheel. It consists of a box of buttons and a steering wheel spinner that allows you to turn the wheel and at the same time control: indicators, lights, windscreen wipers, horn emergency lights. When you don't use the device, you can simply remove the spinner and control buttons and leaving only the bracket on the wheel.

You can place the power-box in any point on the ring of the wheel.

The transmitter sends the impulses to the receiver by radio-waves.

When the transmitter and receiver are far from each other the signal is not broken as with Infra-Red type systems.

Lack of interferences with other electric/electronic apparatuses in the car (power-stations, mobile-phones, radio's, external electronic signals and other apparatus
